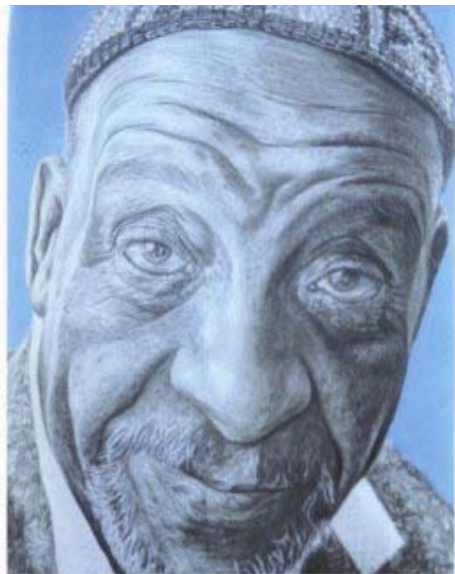

MEMORIAL CELEBRATION TRIBUTE
for
MUHAMMAD SALAHUDEEN
founder, University of the Streets
[March 23, 1930 – November 15, 2007]

In 1967 Muhammad Salahuddeen founded the University of the Streets [UOTS] on 7th Street and Avenue A, on the Lower East Side, Manhattan, to enrich the community with education & work training and *also music and the arts*. *Known for its week-end late-night jazz jam sessions*, many jazz luminaries were known to come by and jam. During the 1970's UOTS obtained government grants to offer low-income community residents vocational training in plumbing, carpentry and electrical work and business and secretarial studies. Their training lives on in the theater they designed and constructed which continues to date to house *jazz concerts, a jazz vocal workshop, poetry series, and other events*. Jam Sessions and The Jazz Vocal Workshop continue, weekends and during the week. The Nisei Goju-Ryu Karate Dojo is also housed on the 3rd floor of the UOTS.
